





Frankie wants to enjoy one last night out in her home town before returning to university – but must fight to stay alive when a mysterious man wearing a Mr Punch mask starts a deadly rampage. Shot on location in Hastings, Punch stars newcomers Alina Allison, Faye Campbell, and Macaulay Cooper, in the lead roles. Joining them are a host of familiar faces from TV and film including Jamie Lomas (Hollyoaks), Kierston Wareing (Fish Tank) and Daniel Fathers (The Witcher).

"Punch is a traditional slasher film, but it also taps into the folk horror vibes of the British seaside and the childhood creepiness of a Punch & Judy show."

Andy Edwards is an award-winning writer and director. He has made two previous feature films: "Ibiza Undead" and "Graphic Desires."



#### "One for the Books: The Maupin Marathon" **Q&A** with Rose Collis



A heartwarming, humorous, uplifting and powerful piece of documentary story-telling revealing many historic episodes that have been hidden or forgotten. In 1985, a small group of seasoned and non-violent LGBT activists and performers (including the film's director) staged the 'Maupin Marathon' fundraiser: a 28-hour non-stop rehearsed reading of the first four of Armistead Maupin's 'Tales of the City' novels (the only time this has happened) to save Gay's The Word bookshop after it was raided and prosecuted by HM Customs. The event became a legend in LGBT history and a perfect example of how a individuals could transcend political differences for the greater good of their community.

Rose Collis is an internationally acclaimed writer, performer, musician, historian, activist and now podcaster and filmmaker. She has written, edited or contributed to 17 books.

"It's been my quest for decades, through my writing and stage work, to share stories of hidden/forgotten lesbian and gay/feminist history from an authentic view, not borrowed or appropriated, as happens all too often."

Bindu de Stoppani is an award-winning scriptwriter and director, who began her journey in film and television as an actress ("The Beach" & "28 Days Later"). She wrote and directed her first short film in 2000, "Things I Notice, Things You See" starring (a then unknown) Michael Fassbender, followed by three further shorts "Gesundheit!" (winner of the Prix Europa Prize), "Three", and "The Kiss". Bindu went on to write and direct her first feature film "Jump", which won five awards at the 2012 British Independent Film Festival including Best Director and Best Feature Film. She has since directed two critically-acclaimed feature films ("Finding Camille" and "40 & Climbing" and showran a new Netflix Italy original series "An Astrological Guide for Broken Hearts."

### BURNT FLOWERS Directed by Michael Fausti

Set in two time periods; the late 1960s and the early 1990s, the film's plot sees Detective Francis Alban embroiled in a missing persons case in which all is not what it seems. The trail leads her to a 1960s serial killer who was never caught and a violent gangster. As Detective Alban delves deeper into the criminal underbelly of Swinging Sixties London, will she uncover more about herself than she is willing to face? Past crimes, revenge and obsessive love collide in this haunting and surreal Horror-Noir.

Michael Fausti is a director, writer and actor. Rarely predictable and often eschewing the constraints of genre and narrative, Fausti's work has been described as "surreal", "shocking" and "a swan dive into the depths of the dark side of human behaviour." He cites his cinematic influences as the films of Michael Powell, Nic Roeg, Derek Jarman and Jean Rollin.


